  - Needs assessment:
    - 4-6 buildings, (Arena for show, sheep barn for dog tie-outs, food vendors, pavilion for seating, restrooms, and 4-H Building for HQ) as well as spaces for camper availability and truck parking.
  - o 24 states represented whole family affair
  - 4-H clubs are welcome to host the concession stands; though more feasible to allow food vendors to just open up their stands – needs to be open 24/7 for 3 days
  - Thursday night the English Association hosts a paid per plate dinner might be a fundraiser opportunity for a 4-H Club or Junior Leaders.

- Looking at about \$3000 budget
- Potential for 20 vendors to set up in an outdoor facility (lockable preferred)
